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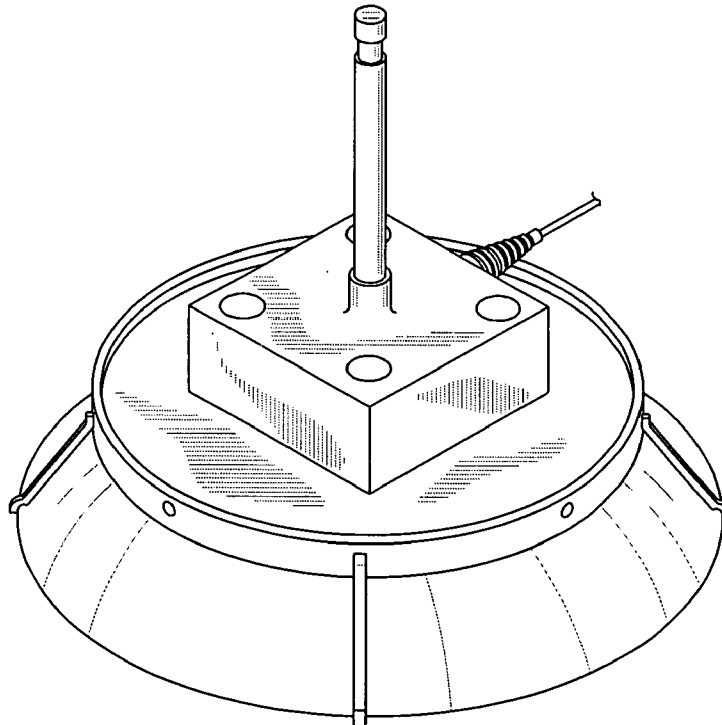
(57) **CLAIM**

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front side view of the lighting fixture for film and television production;
FIG. 2 is a back side view of the lighting fixture for film and television production;

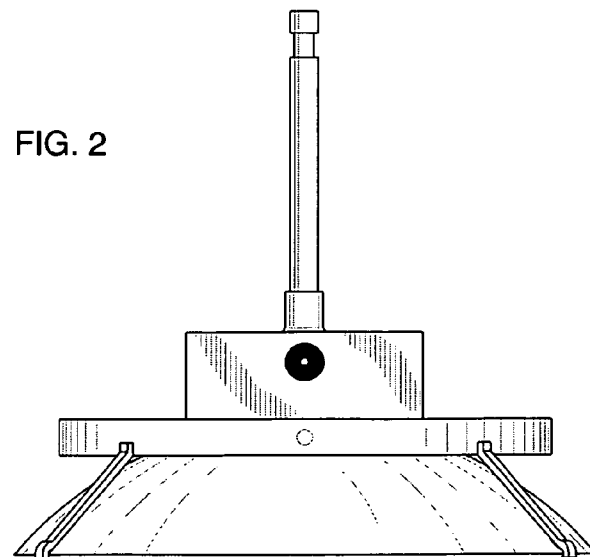
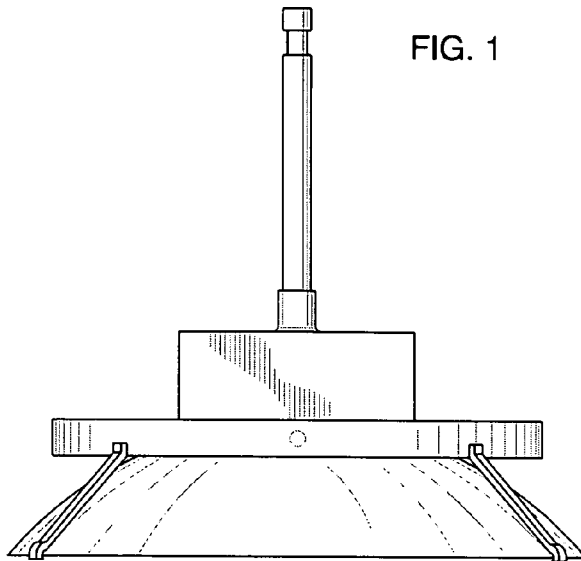

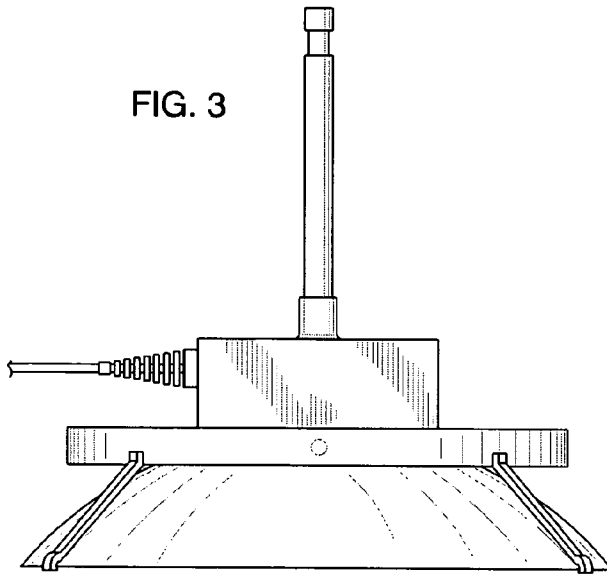

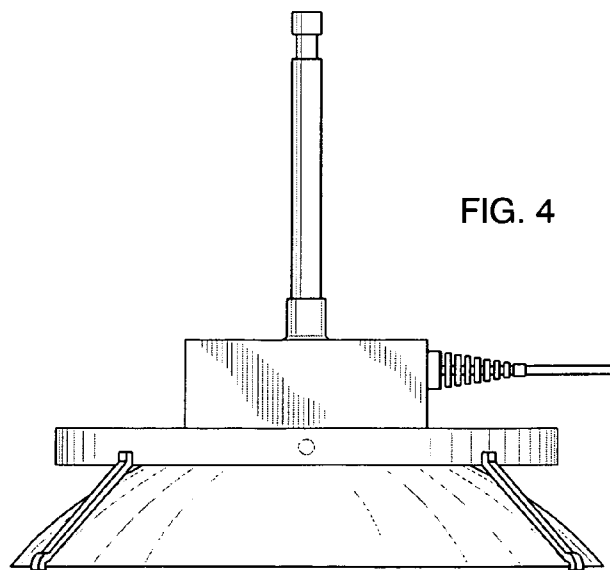

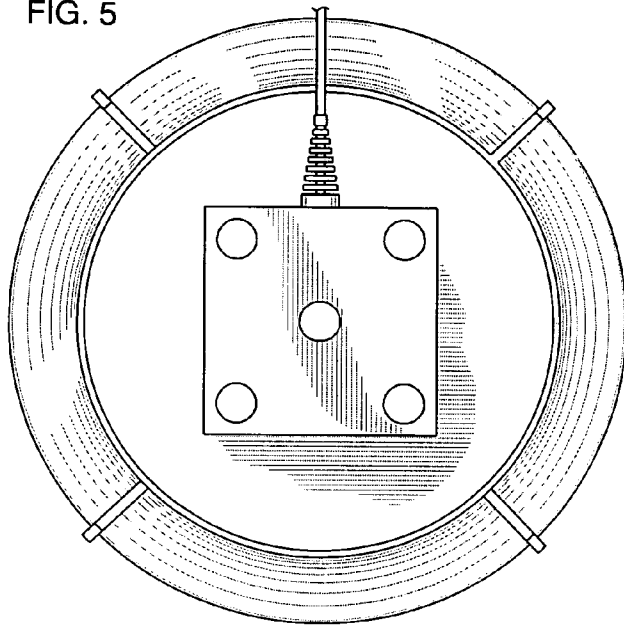

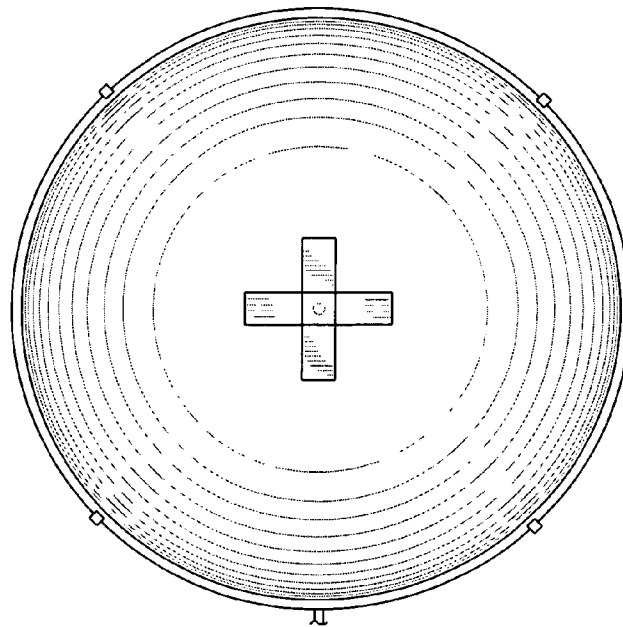

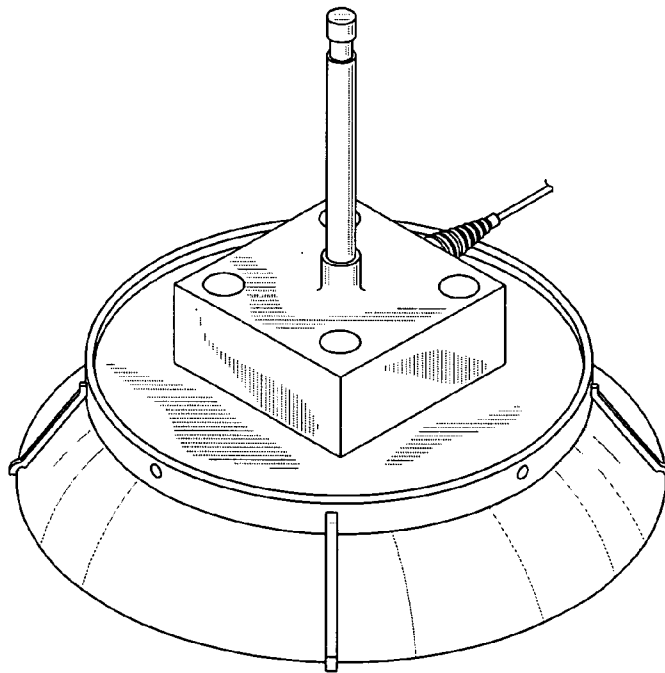
