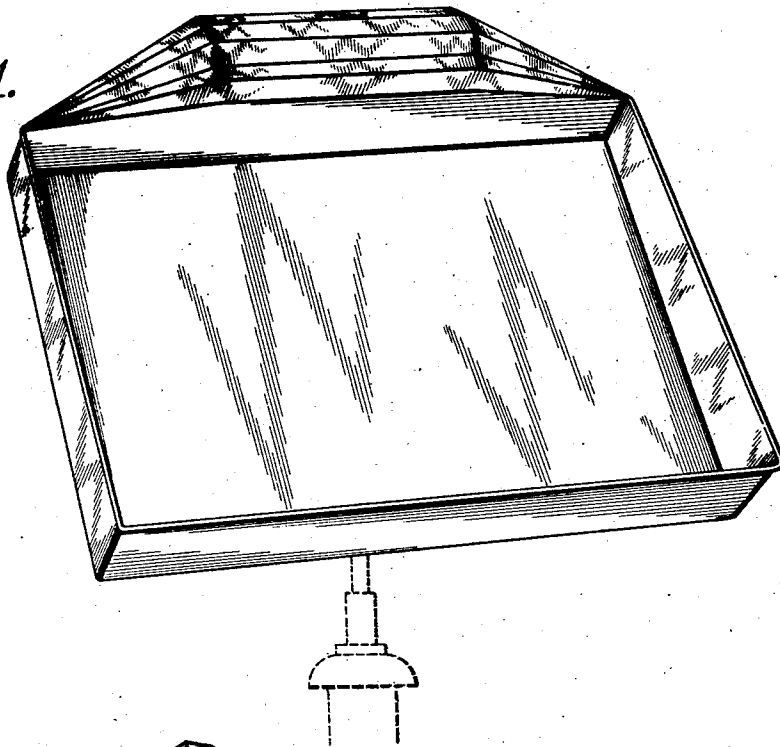
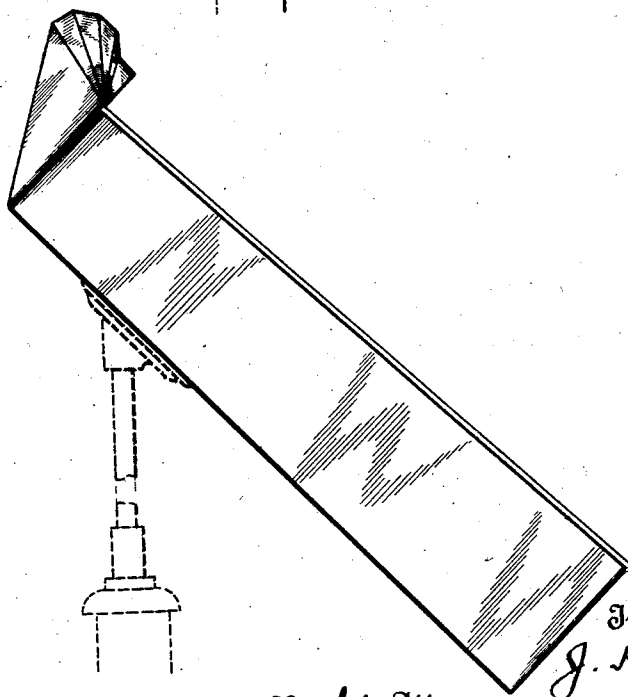

DESIGN FOR A MUSIC STAND.

Application filed January 9, 1928. Serial No. 24,783. Term of patent 7 years

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, JOHN H. KLIEGL, a citizen of the United States of America, residing at New York, county and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Music Stand, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.
